Fleeting traces of a Hungarian student in Italy

Giulio Langer was the son of Isidor and was born in Kemend (Hungary) on October 15, 1913.

He moved to Siena and enrolled in the department of Medicine and Surgery in 1933 (document #1754). As happened with almost the entire group of foreign Jewish university students, the Police Headquarters made inquiries with the university office as to the status of Giulio Langer. The response, dated January 27, 1939, indicates that in the academic year 1938-39, Langer was enrolled in his sixth year. His request to take the final exams was submitted on June 26, 1939. He graduated on July 15, 1939.
