Biographical sketch of a Jewish student in Italy

Lida Lerner was born in Odessa (Russia) on 10 January 1913. Jewish citizen, daughter of Imuli Zelmanovici, she was enrolled at the University of Siena in the Department of Medicine and Surgery from 1934-35 (registration #1860). In 1937, she spent a year in Turin and then returned to Siena. Always properly enrolled, she graduated on 15 July 1939. The Police Department requested information on her status at the University on 18 January 1939. She had enrolled in her sixth year on 18 November 1938.
