Emigration to Palestine and then to Italy to further her education

Zelda Youdassin was born in 1913 at Ekaterinoslav (today Dnipro), in the Ukraine; her parents, Meyer and Reisa Kuna, subsequently decided to emigrate to Palestine¹. Ekaterinoslav was the seat of a large Jewish community, which was decimated during the extermination². After receiving her diploma, Zelda emigrated to Italy and enrolled in the Pharmacy Department in Rome in the 1933-34 academic year. She transferred to Florence in her fourth year in 1936-37, graduating from the Pharmacy Department on 9 November 1939, with a thesis entitled «Sintesi di un derivato dell'antipirina», receiving a grade of 92/110. Her supervisor was Mario Passerini, professor of Pharmaceutical Chemistry and Director of the School of Pharmacy³. Youdassin, who was no longer enrolled, was able to take advantage of the extra session in November 1939 as part of the previous academic year. This was the last opportunity to avoid expulsion.

In 1940 Zelda returned to Tel Aviv, where the Palestinian authorities recognized her license to practice her profession⁴.
