### **Medical student from France to Italy**

David Bornsztejn, son of Henoch, was born in Warsaw on 16 July 1914. He began medical school at the University of Montpellier, moving to Florence as a third-year student in 1934-35. From 1936 he was enrolled in Siena (Student ID 1936).

On 16 October 1938, he defended his thesis, and he graduated on 31 October 1938. Questura records are imprecise regarding his name, though it appears on the list of foreign Jewish residents in Siena, as prepared for the municipality by the University of Siena on 18 August 1938<sup>1</sup>.
